- Presentation of Bills         Please give outstanding bills to Joyce Edds, CMA (AAMA), CPT (ASCP)
- Correspondence                Correspondence was presented by Glennella Bruce, RN, CMA-C (AAMA) pro-tem Corresponding Secretary. Betty Springer, CMA-C (AAMA), President, sent highlights of the June Board of Trustees and Endowment Meeting, held in Renton, Washington . The Speaker of the House, Christine Hollander sent the delegate's packets. Joyce Garribay, CMA (AAMA), Chair of the Bylaws and Resolutions Committee sent a letter to address the Indiana State Bylaws, they found bylaws to be technically in compliance with the AAMA Bylaws, however, ISMA Bylaws make no mention of Member-At-Large. The committee recommends adding language to address this category and they sent possible language to revise the Indiana State Bylaws to include this category. One copy of the Bylaws will be filed with the AAMA Bylaws chair and one with AAMA Executive Office. Article 4 section 7 of the AAMA Bylaws now states it will only be necessary to review bylaws after notification from AAMA that mandated bylaws are changed. Bylaws will not be automatically reviewed every 3 years, if at any time there are questions or need to make significant changes, we can contact the AAMA Bylaw's committee.

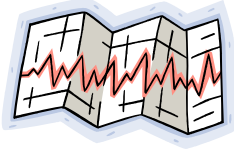

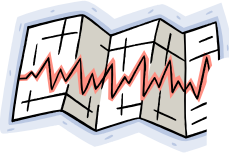
